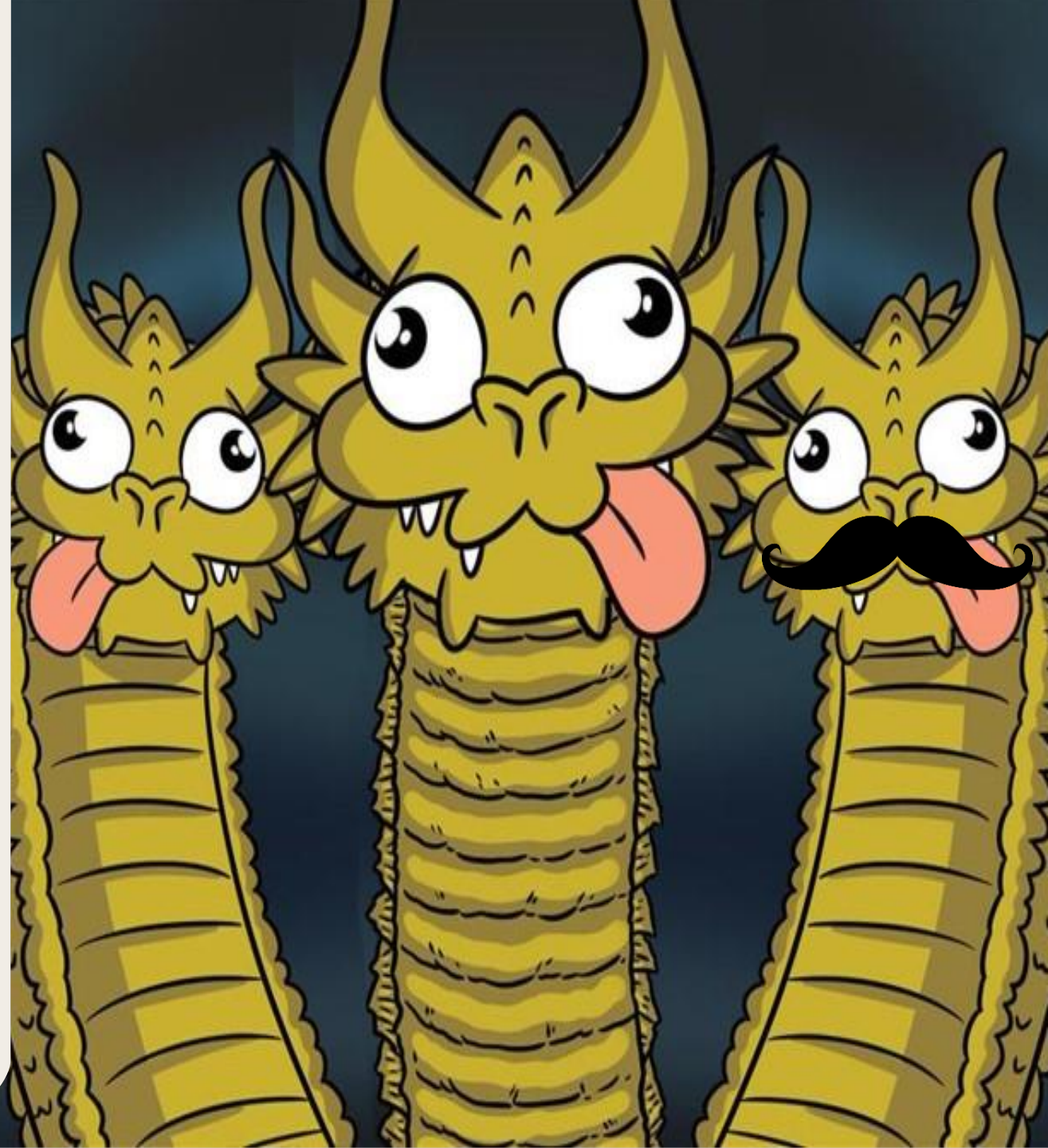


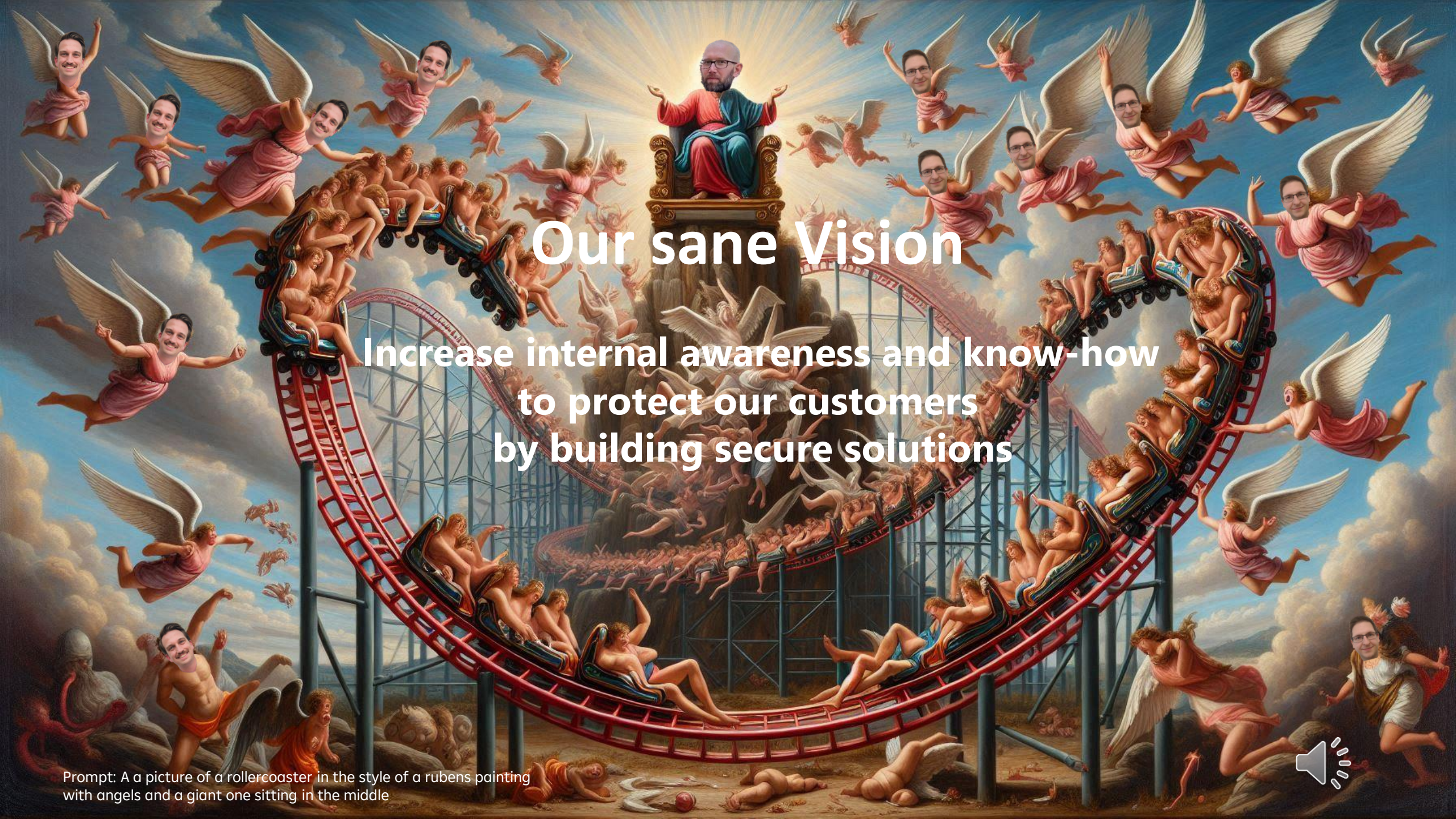

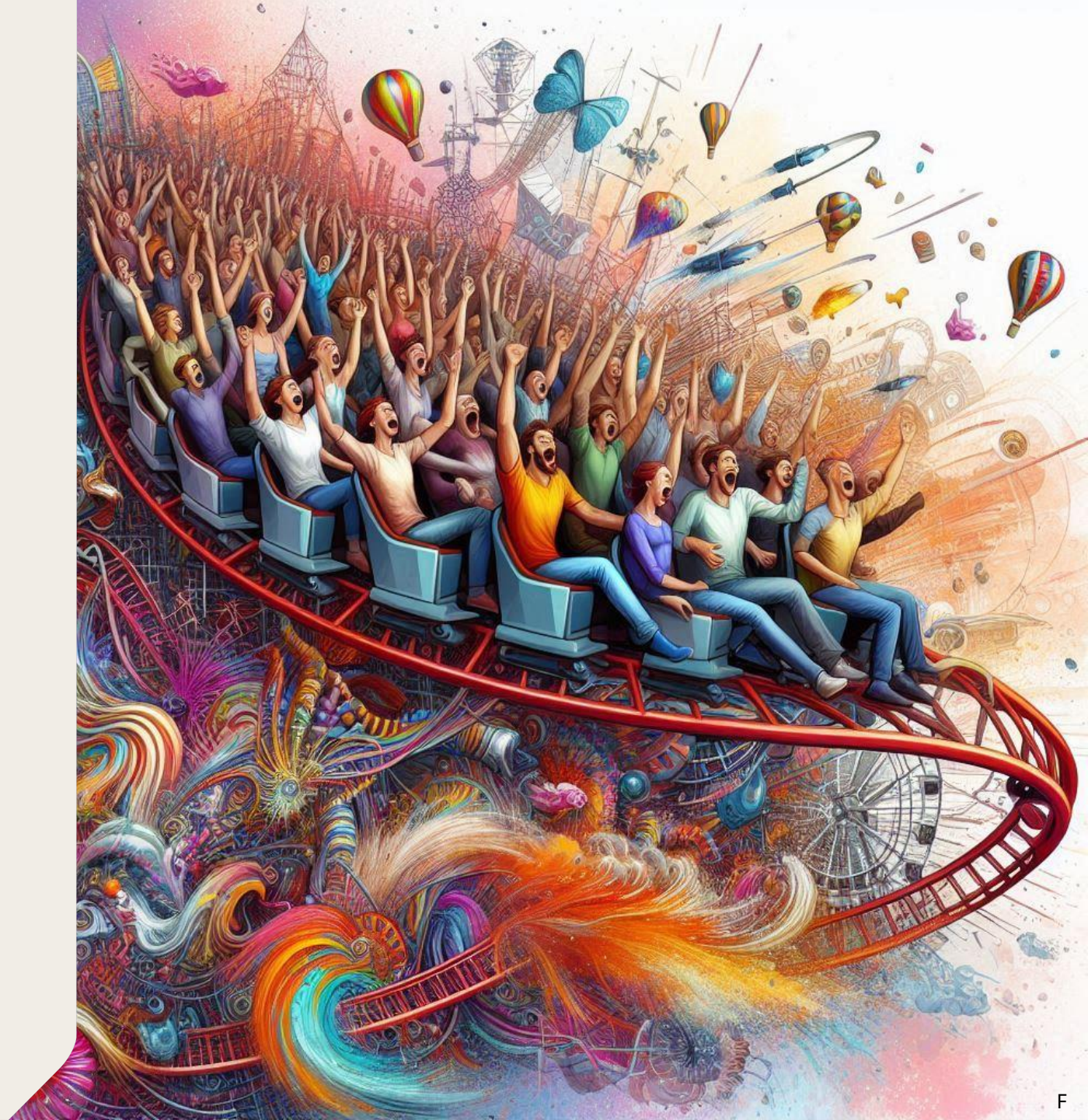


Why (in)sanity?

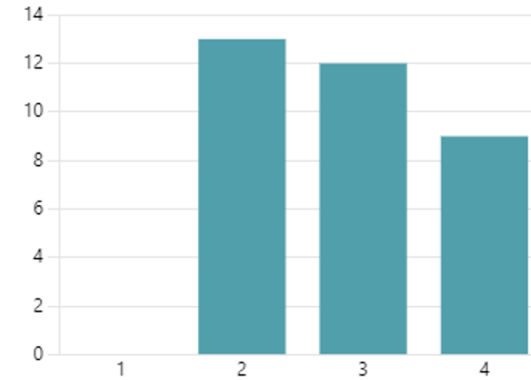
How do you rate the offering of the Security CoP? (Community, Monthly Meetings, ...)

Did your understanding of cyber security increase by attending the CoP monthly meetings?

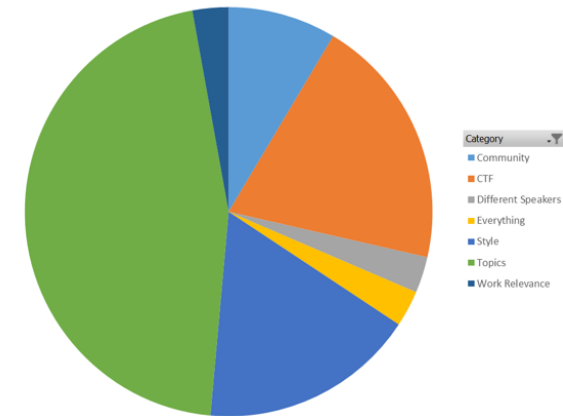

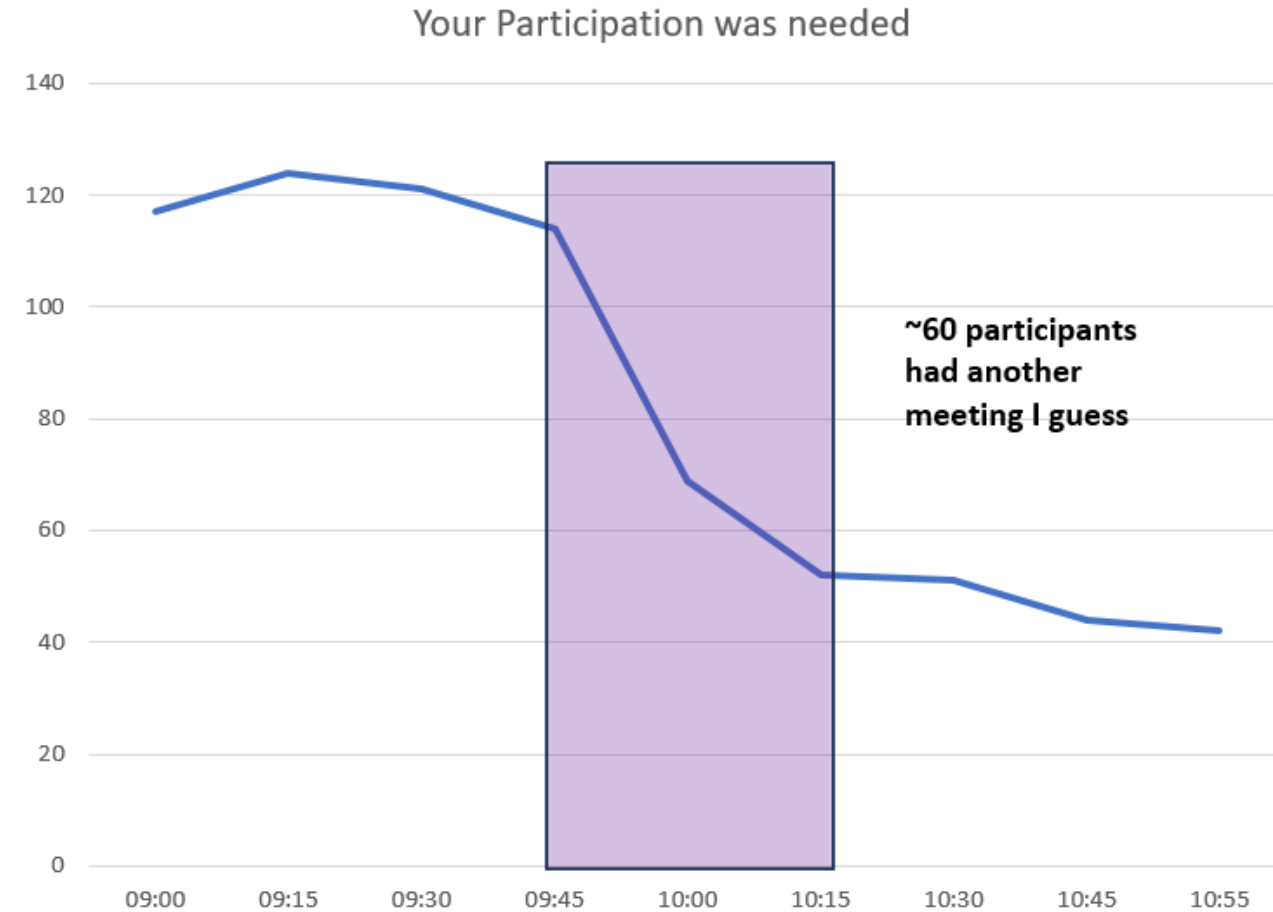
